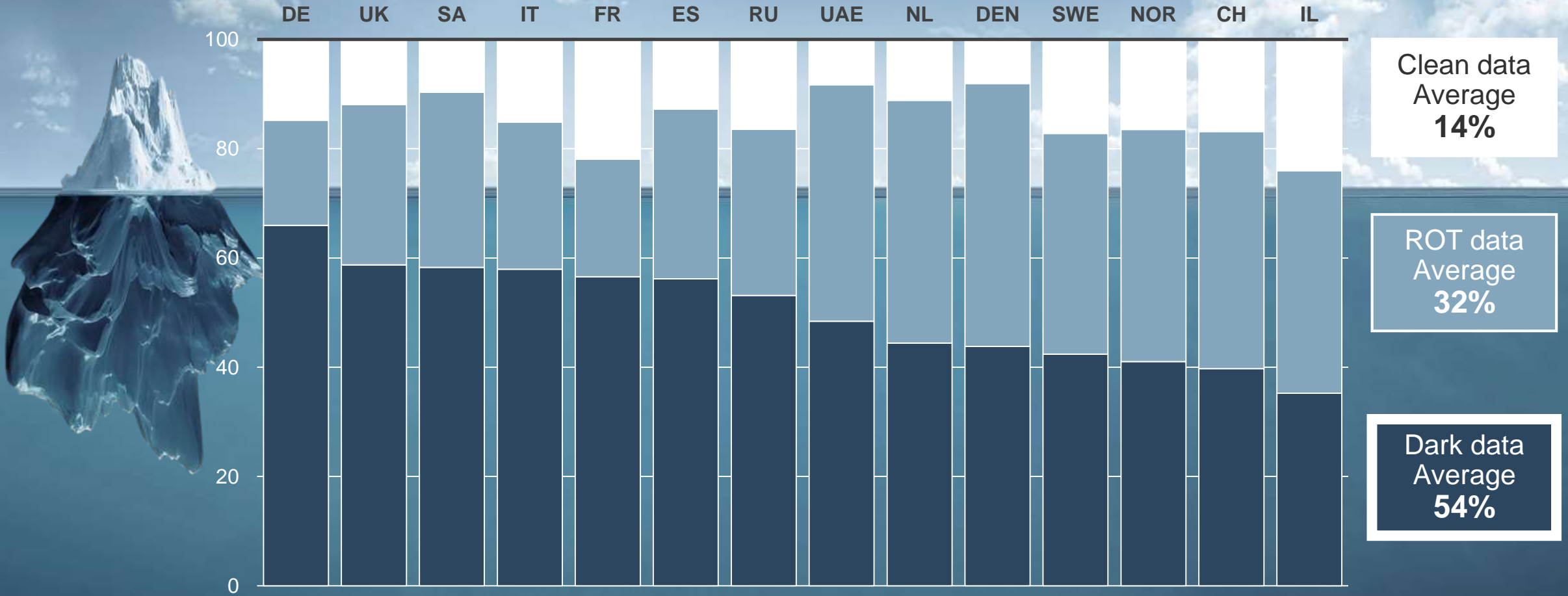

The issues and attitudes.....

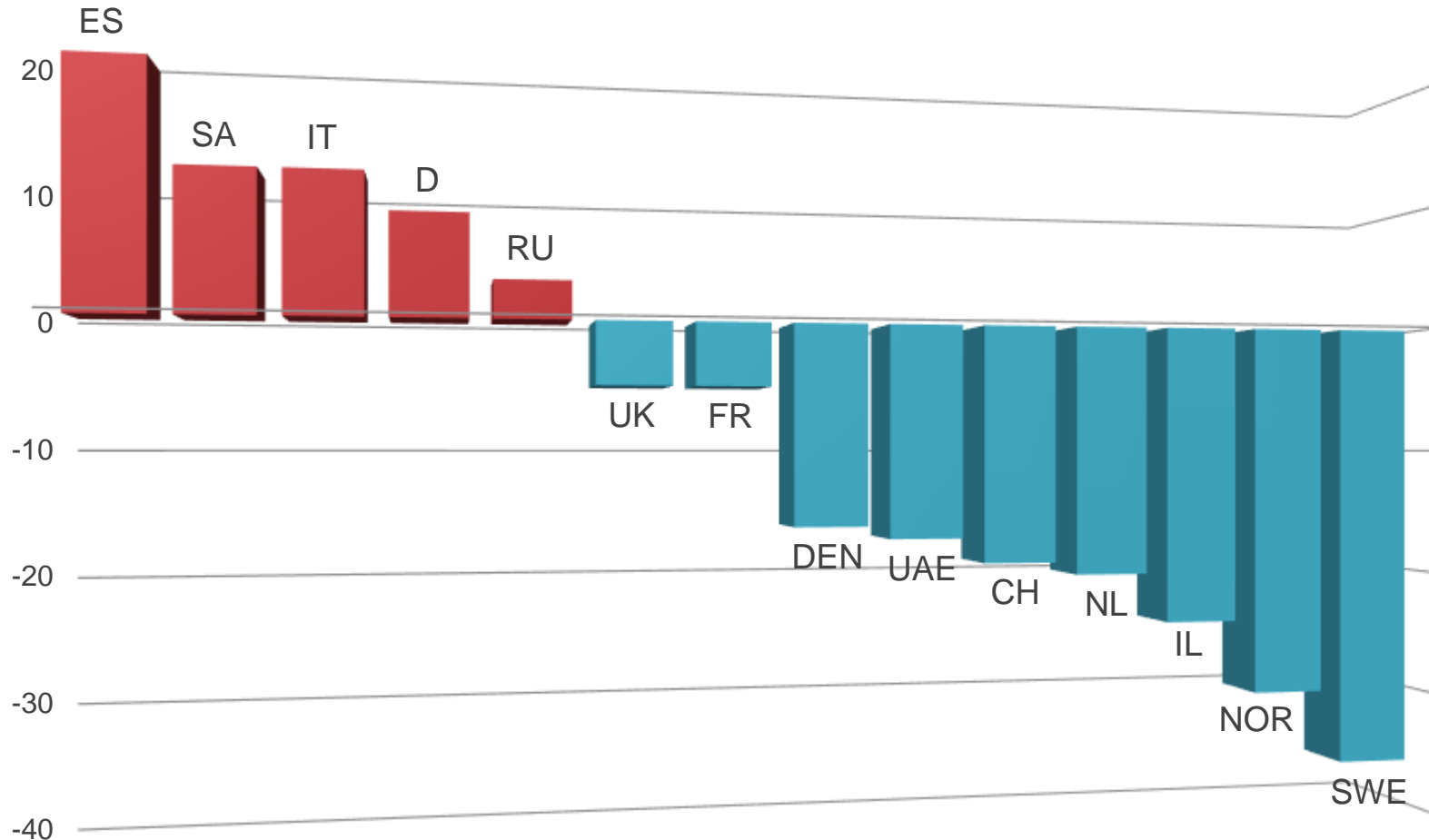
1 Strategies based on data volumes not business value

2 Increased reliance on 'free' storage and the acceleration to cloud

3 A growing disregard for corporate data policies by employees

Today, data volumes, not business value, drives IT strategy and budget

One fifth of EU organisations don't know the business value of their data



THE RIGHT WAY
More value = more budget

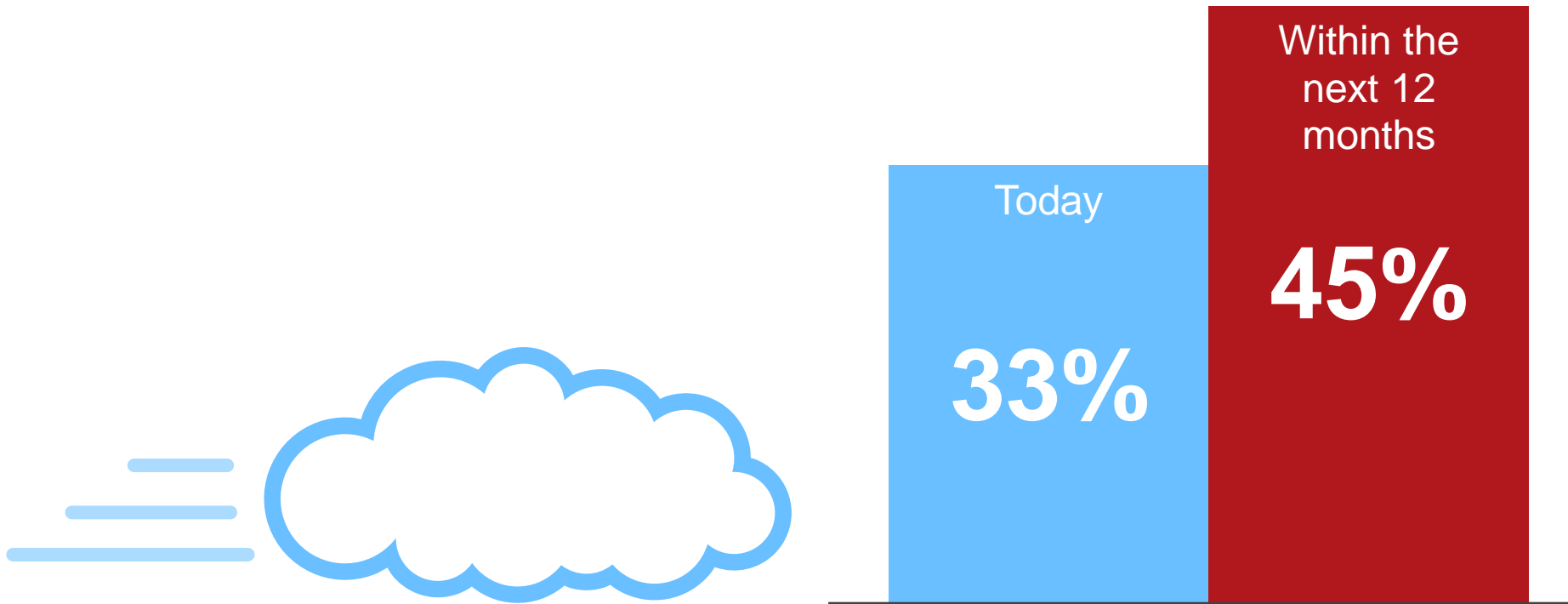
% differential between those costing on volume rather than value

THE WRONG WAY
Larger volume = more budget

Meanwhile, the mass migration of data to the cloud is accelerating...

Cloud storage and processing to increase by a third in 2016

Average % of data estimated to be in the cloud

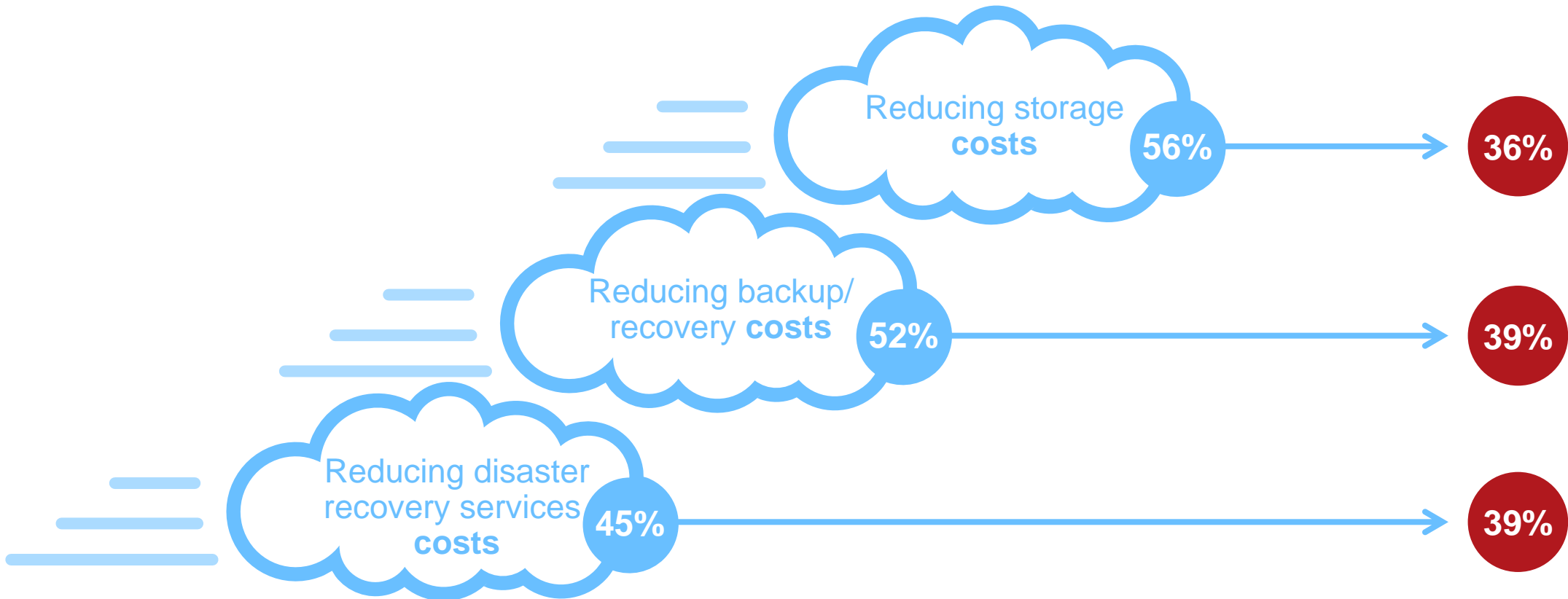


...due to the perception of the cloud as a short-term cost saver

Cost drives cloud adoption but is not a future concern

What's driving it?

*Future concern:
Increasing cost over time?*



Employees see data storage as “Free”, so they use Sync & Share services with, or without, permission

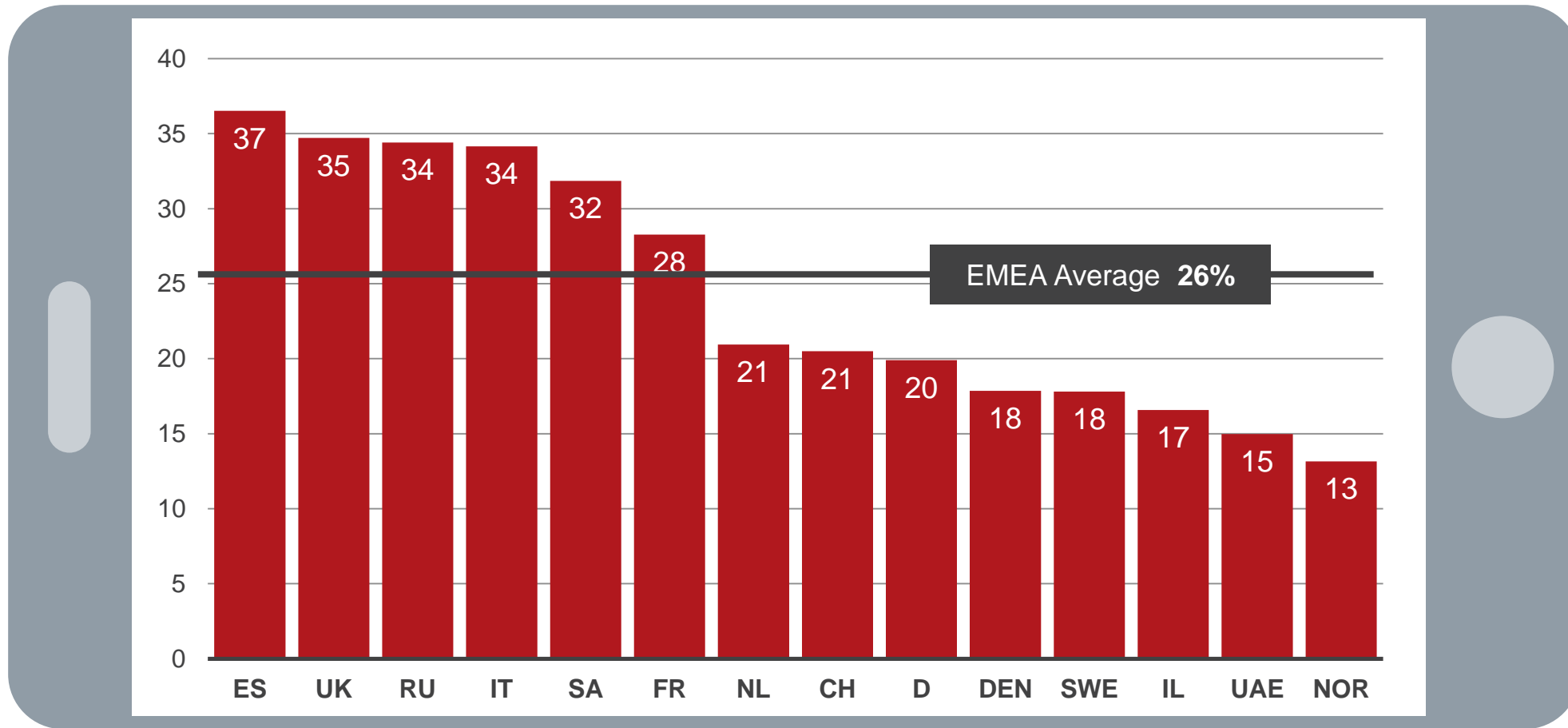


92% of EMEA employees use Sync & Share service within policy...

..but 62% violate policy using other Sync & Share not sanctioned

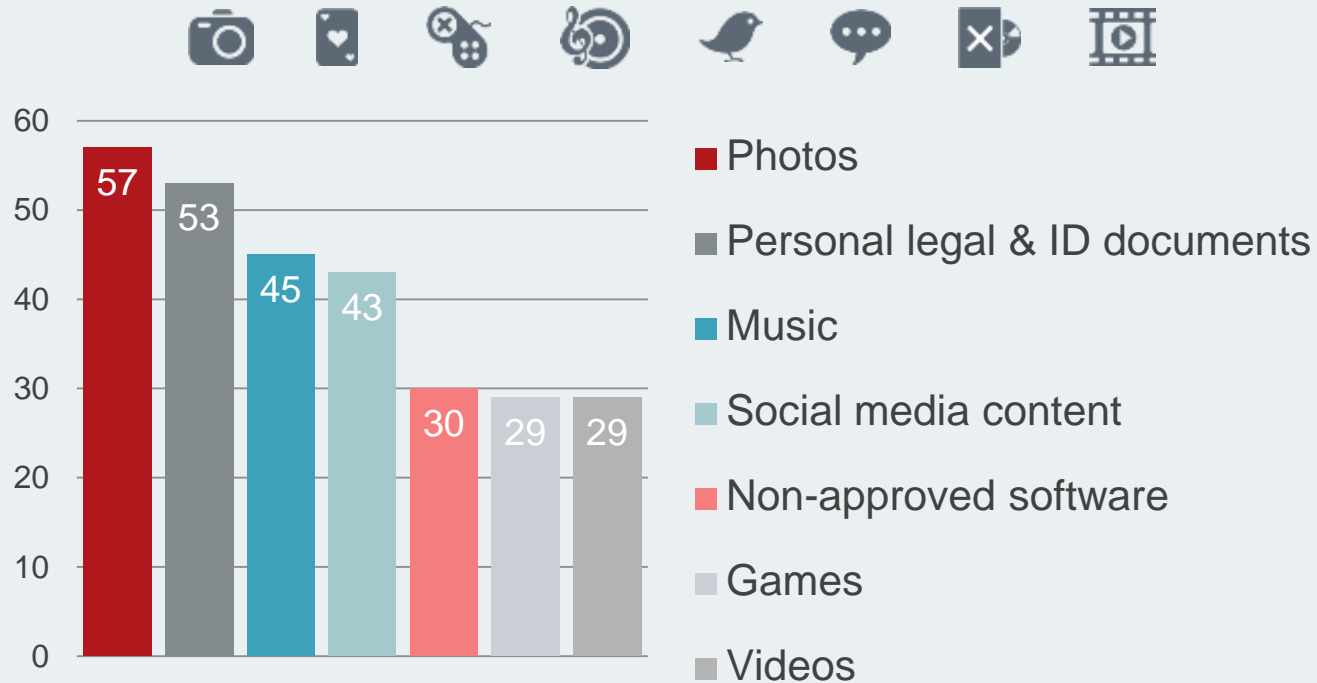
Today's employees treat work IT resources as their own Personal IT infrastructure

Average % of employees storing data on work devices

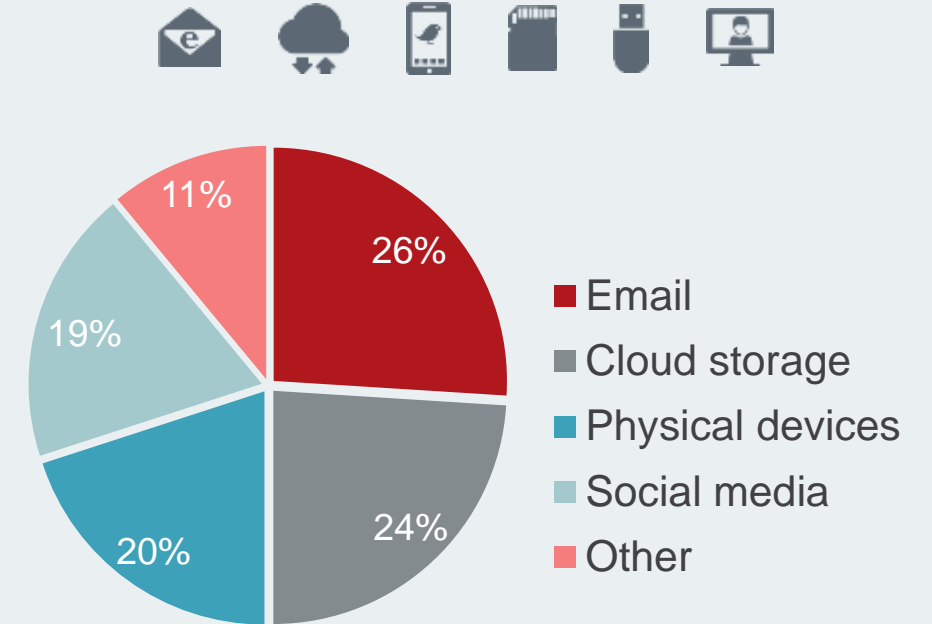


More personal data than ever exists on corporate networks

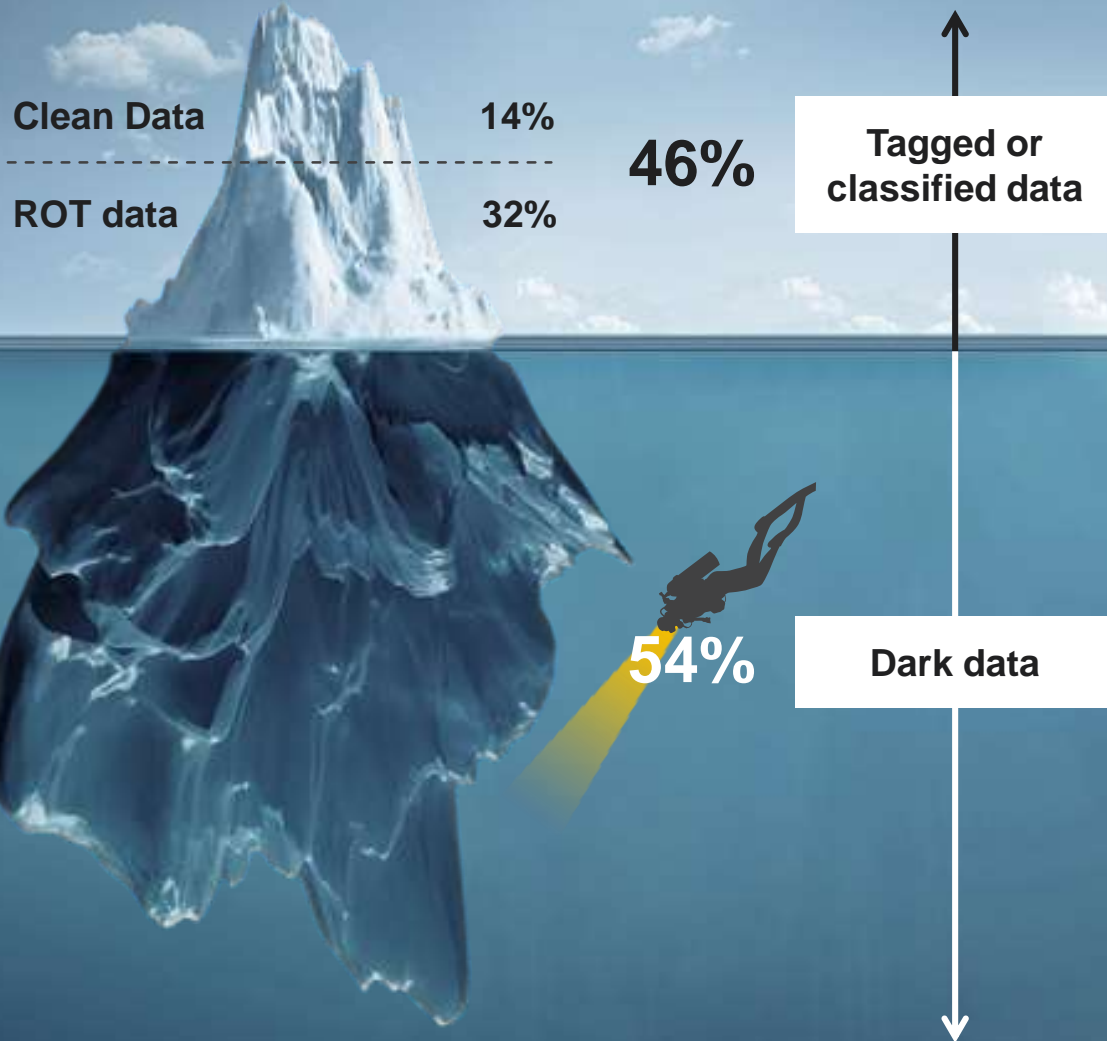

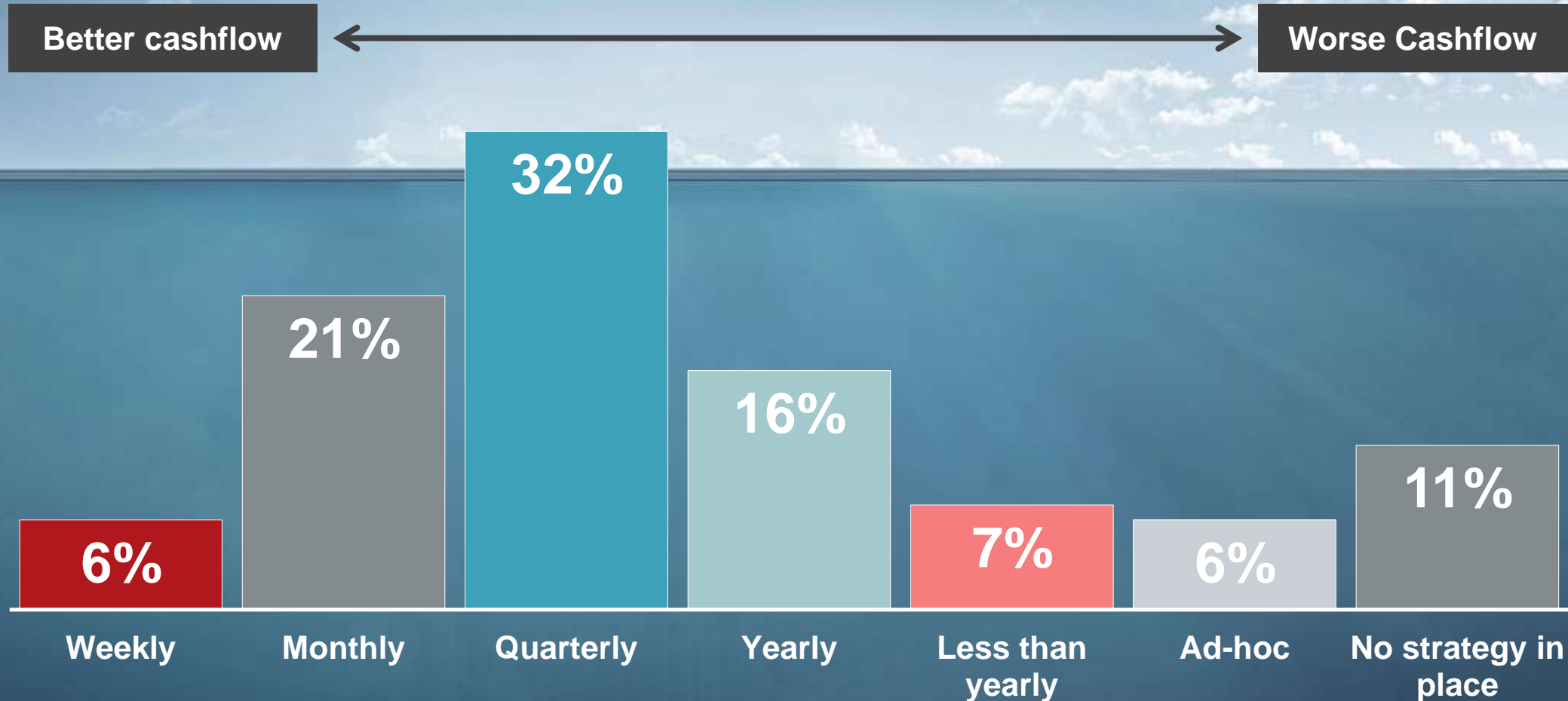
Gain Visibility: Illuminate your Dark Data



Establish an Information Governance strategy based on value

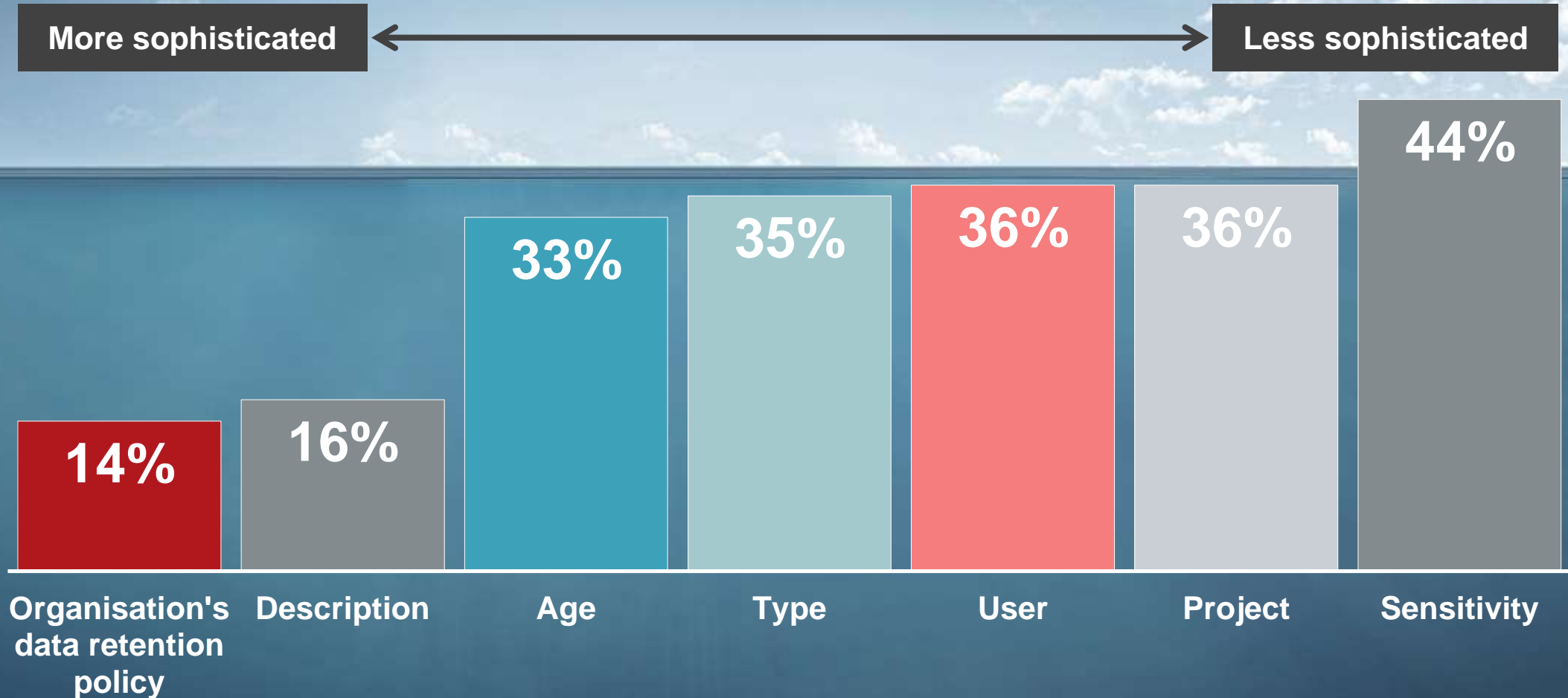
Take action: eliminate the ROT

Organisations IT policy stating when ROT data has to be deleted



Take action: create a standard for data classification

How an organisation classifies or tags the data it stores



Assume control: nudge employee behaviour

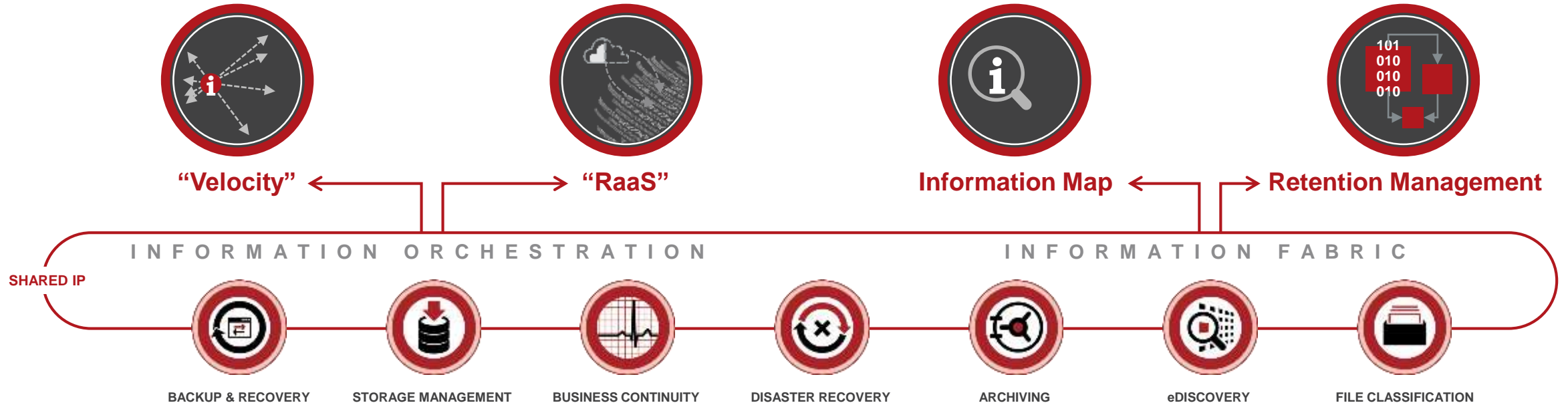
